Dear David and Zeny,


First of all I want to thank you for the excellent care your organization has given my mom for the last 3 years! The San Vicente house has been a cheerful nurturing environment and the staff is very caring and patient.

My husband learned last month that he is being transferred to Norcross, GA around May 1st. We visited the area last weekend and found a nice residential care home, Heavens Gardens Senior Care, in Dacula, GA that has a vacancy for Mom. I know I need to give a minimum of 30 days notice to you so let this letter serve that function, however I don't yet know the exact timing I will be moving her. I am unable to fly her on the same flight my husband and I will be taking, so I may need to schedule a flight after our cars have reached Atlanta.

We will need to have some forms filled out and a TB test for her, which I am sure your nurse can read, but I will bring those forms over within the next week or so and drop them off at the house.
